Funding Information

Caterpillars Preschool is registered to take:

- 2 year additional support to eligible 2 year olds: 15 hours free early education and childcare dependent on an economic criteria, for children looked after by the local authority or children with additional needs.
- Early years education funding (3-4 years): All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to free early education or childcare for 15 hours a week during term time. This starts the term after they are 3.
- 30 hours free childcare: Working parents for 2, 3 and 4 year old children may be entitled to up to 30 hours free childcare. New applications will need to let us know their eligibility code so we can offer you a funded place for your child.
- Early Years Pupil Premium: For 3 and 4 year old children whose parents are in receipt of certain qualifying benefits, or who have been adopted or are in care.
- Tax free childcare: A government scheme to support working parents with childcare costs. For every £8 you pay in, the government will pay in an extra £2.

When to apply for 30 hours of free childcare:

You can apply from when your child is 23 weeks old. When you can get your hours from will depend on the date your child turns 9 months old.

When your child turns 9 months old	When you can get your hours from	Deadline for applying
Between 1 September and 31 December	1 January	31 December
Between 1 January and 31 March	1 April	31 March
Between 1 April and 31 August	1 September	31 August
